## Apply Early- Apply Often

Applications open in November. The more you apply to, the better your chances!



## Stay Organized

## Use the Search Feature

Utilize the drop-down menu and keyword search function of our website to find scholarships. Mix it up, reset and take notes as you search.

## Make Your Essay Count

Your essay is a crucial component of the application. It's the best way to tell your story. Be detailed, thorough and check for typos.



## Don't Get Discouraged

Sometimes, even your best efforts don't yield a scholarship award. Keep trying for each year you are enrolled in school.
